## PRESIDENTS MESSAGE

March was a very busy month for all of us at MLSC with State competition at Junior and Senior level really hotting up at Kingscliff. JAC Chairman Steve Wilton led 135 nippers up the coast with great expectations and was not disappointed. In all age groups and in all disciplines we excelled, producing a great result for the club and a strong endorsement for our outstanding coaching program. I would like to highlight one display from Cooper Krenkels in the U/14 swim. The chairman of Cronulla nippers described it as the best swim he has ever seen - praise indeed. What an asset Cooper will be next year in the senior ranks.

The following week the Masters and Opens gave us more of the same with MLSC retaining our Open State title. Special mention goes to Sammy Speer, Trent Klouzal and Liam Kelly who won the U/19 taplin by the closest of margins. A huge cheer squad watched Trent win the gold by less than a metre from Cronulla with Redhead a couple of feet behind. Moments later the girls won the Open swim on the same stretch

of beach with four of our girls finishing in the top five finishers. Remarkable.

Both nippers and seniors competed with outstanding sportsmanship and are a great credit to our club.

Aussies are now in full swing with veteran competitor Mark Epper winning our first points in his pet event the 2km sprint with a fourth placing .

One of our great champions Mel Pelly got Silver in the final of the Australian Champion Lifesaver. This is her seventh year in a row winning the State Championship, and seven consecutive National titles with a top three finish- 3 gold, 3 silver, and a bronze.....this lady truly is a legend who has combined surf skills with life saving skills better than anybody else. Next stop for Mel is qualification for the "Old and Bold"!
